RESOLUTION OF CLEVELAND TOWNSHIP,
COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
PROVIDING FOR A FINDING WHERE THE ZONING ORDINANCE IS DEEMED
SUBSTANTIALLY INVALID FOR IT'S LACK OF RULES FOR SOLAR PROJECTS IN
CLEVELAND TOWNSHIP,
FOR SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, act of July 31, 1968, as amended 53 P.S. §§10101 et seq., enables a municipality through its zoning ordinance to regulate the use of property and to promote the conservation of energy through access to and use of renewable energy resources;

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to set forth that the Cleveland Township Zoning Ordinance is substantially invalid in regard to solar projects within the Township.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cleveland, Columbia County, Pennsylvania and it is enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be a 180 day moratorium on any and all solar projects within Cleveland Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania or sooner if the solar energy system ordinance is passed, then this resolution will become null and void.

SECTION 2 This resolution shall take effect immediately.
